

## USE OF PARKER CITY LAKE

Parker City Lake is intended for the use and enjoyment of the citizens of Parker and Linn County, Kansas. However, the failure of anyone using the lake to abide by the following regulations may result in their being denied the use of the lake in the future.

### USE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The user shall be responsible for the following care and cleaning of the surrounding areas used:

- A. Parker City Lake shall be limited to a stay of not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days in a campsite unless authorized by written permission from the City Police Chief or City Mayor.
- B. To reserve a campsite, the applicant must be 18 or older. Anyone 17 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult while camping.
- C. Reserving a campsite requires the completion of an application, photo ID, and signature acknowledging the rules and regulations of Parker City Lake.
- D. The restroom is to be left in a neat and sanitary condition.
- E. Trash should be placed in the receptacles provided.
- F. Camping sites shall not be left unoccupied for more than 24 hours.
- G. Vehicles or other property shall not be left unattended on campground lands or water for more than 24 hours.
- H. Do not remove any tables, benches, or trash receptacles from the premises.
- I. Failure to follow these rules and regulations can result in being denied future use.

**The cooperation and care of Parker City Lake is very important for its continual use and the City would ask the users to care for the lake as if it were their own.**
